Review of 208 Bible Questions from Genesis to Revelation

If you have gone over these weekly lessons in the past year, you have been exposed to the basic story of the Bible. The lessons were chronological, so that hopefully you have a better grasp of the events that happened and how they relate to one another and to the message God is giving us in His word. Having finished the devotional readings, perhaps you would like to review by revisiting the questions.

How well did you do in the last year as you went through the Bible? Check by going through the questions and see if you can remember the answers. If you have read through these devotionals with your family, check to see how well your family can answer the questions.

- Q1 Who was in the beginning?
A God was in the beginning.
- Q2 What did God do in the beginning?
A In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.
- Q3 Was God created?
A No. God was before all things and He created all things.
- Q4 Was anything made without God?
A No. God made all things.
- Q5 How many days did God take to make things?
A God made things in six days.
- Q6 What did God make in six days?"
A God made the heaven and the earth, the sea and everything in them in six days.
- Q7 What did God make in the first three days of creation?
A On day 1 He separated light from darkness.
On day 2 He separated water above the sky from water below the sky.
On day 3 He separated land from water and made plants.

- Q8 What did God make in the last three days of creation?
A On day 4 the sun, moon and stars
On day 5 birds and sea creatures
On day 6 animals and man
- Q9 What was all of creation like when God made it?
A All of creation was very good, including man.
- Q10 What rule did God make for Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden?
A They were not to eat of the Tree of Knowledge of good and evil.
- Q11 What did God say would happen if they ate the forbidden fruit?
A They would die the same day.
- Q12 Who tempted Eve to doubt God's word?
A The serpent tempted Eve to doubt God's word.
- Q13 What did Adam do when Eve offered him the fruit?
A Adam disobeyed God when he ate the fruit.
- Q14 Why did Adam and Eve hide from God?
A They hid from God because they had sinned.
- Q15 What hope did God give to Adam and Eve even though they sinned?
A God promised that one day the seed of the woman would bruise the serpent's head.
- Q16 What did God do because Adam disobeyed Him?
A God brought a curse on the world because Adam disobeyed Him.
- Q17 What came into the world because of Adam's sin?
A Death came into the world because of Adam's sin.
- Q18 Who was the first murderer?
A The first murderer was Adam's son Cain, who killed his brother Abel.
- Q19 How wicked did man become after Adam's sin?
A Man became so wicked that he always did evil.
- Q20 How did God feel about man's wickedness?
A He felt so sorry He made man that He decided to destroy mankind.
- Q21 Why did God save Noah during the flood?
A God saved Noah because he was righteous.
- Q22 Where was the place of safety during the flood?
A The ark was the place God provided for safety in the flood.
- Q23 How much of the earth was covered by the flood?
A The whole earth was covered by more than twenty feet of water.
- Q24 What was destroyed in the flood?
A All living creatures on land were destroyed except for those on the ark.
- Q25 How do man and animals relate after the flood?
A Man can eat animals, and animals are afraid of man.
- Q26 What rule did God give to protect man from murder?
A Man has authority to punish a murderer by death.
- Q27 What is the rainbow?
A The rainbow is the token of God's promise not to ever again destroy the earth by flood.
- Q28 How did God populate the earth after the Tower of Babel?
A God confused the language of man and scattered man over the earth.
- Q29 What did God ask Abraham to do?
A God asked Abraham to leave his country for a new country.

- Q30 What did God promise to Abraham?
A God promised Abraham a land, a nation, a name, and a blessing.
- Q31 How was God going to bless Abraham's family?
A God promised he would have too many descendents to count.
- Q32 Through which son of Abraham did God make a covenant?
A God's covenant would come through Isaac.
- Q33 How old was Abraham when Isaac was born?
A Abraham was a hundred years old when Isaac was born.
- Q34 What did God ask Abraham to do with Isaac?
A God asked Abraham to offer Isaac as a sacrifice to the Lord.
- Q35 How did God provide a substitute for Isaac on the altar?
A God provided a ram caught in a thicket to take Isaac's place.
- Q36 From where did a blessing come to Abraham after he offered his son?
A An angel came from heaven with a blessing for Abraham.
- Q37 Who were Isaac's sons?
A Isaac's sons were Jacob and Esau.
- Q38 What did Esau do with his birthright?
A Esau sold his birthright to Jacob for a bowl of pottage.
- Q39 What did God promise to Isaac?
A God promised Isaac what he had promised to Abraham.
- Q40 How did Jacob get the blessing from Isaac?
A Jacob deceived his father and got the blessing.
- Q41 What did God tell Jacob when he dreamed of a ladder to heaven?
A God gave Jacob the blessing of Abraham and Isaac when he dreamed of the ladder going to heaven.
- Q42 What new name did God give Jacob at Peniel?
A God changed Jacob's name to Israel.
- Q43 How many sons did Jacob have whose families became known as "the children of Israel?"
A Jacob had twelve sons whose families became known as the children of Israel.
- Q44 Where did the children of Israel go when there was a great famine?
A The children of Israel went to Egypt when there was a great famine.
- Q45 Why did the king of Egypt mistreat the children of Israel?
A The king of Egypt was afraid that the children of Israel would rebel and flee.
- Q46 Who was born in Egypt during this hard time?
A Moses was born in Egypt during the hard time of the children of Israel.
- Q47 At the burning bush, who spoke to Moses?
A The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob spoke to Moses at the burning bush.
- Q48 What did God ask Moses to do?
A God asked Moses to bring the people out of the land of Egypt.
- Q49 What did Pharaoh say when Moses gave God's message to let His people go?
A Pharaoh said he would not let God's people go.
- Q50 What did God do to Egypt when Pharaoh refused to let the people go?
A God sent plagues on Egypt because Pharaoh would not let the people go.
- Q51 What was the last plague on Egypt?
A The last plague on the people of Egypt was the death of the firstborn in every household.

- Q52 How did the Israelites escape the plague of death?
A The Israelites put lamb's blood on their doorposts, and when God saw it, He passed over that house and spared the firstborn.
- Q53 What did Pharaoh tell Moses after the plague of the firstborn?
A Pharaoh told Moses to take the people away from Egypt and serve the Lord.
- Q54 How did God lead the Children of Israel after they left Egypt?
A He led them with a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night.
- Q55 Where did Pharaoh's army catch up to the Israelites?
A The army came upon Israel at the Red Sea.
- Q56 How did God save Israel from Pharaoh's army?
A He made a way through the Red Sea for Israel, and then drowned the Egyptian army.
- Q57 How did God feed the Children of Israel in the Wilderness?
A He sent them manna from heaven.
- Q58 In what way did God provide water for the Israelites?
A God brought water out of the rock when Moses struck it with the rod.
- Q59 What did God promise Israel if they would obey his voice?
A He promised that they would be a special people if they kept His covenant.
- Q60 Who did God call up to Mt. Sinai to receive the law?
A God called Moses to receive the law.
- Q61 What were the first two commandments?
A 1. Thou shalt have no other gods before me.
2. Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image.
- Q62 What are the third and fourth commandments?
A 3. Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain.
4. Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy.
- Q63 What are commandments five, six and seven?
A 5. Honor thy father and thy mother
6. Thou shalt not kill.
7. Thou shalt not commit adultery.
- Q64 What are the last three commandments?
A 8. Thou shalt not steal.
9. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbor.
10. Thou shalt not covet.
- Q65 What did the Children of Israel do while Moses delayed coming down from Mt. Sinai?
A When Moses delayed coming, the people made a golden calf to worship.
- Q66 What did Moses do when he saw the people dancing before the golden calf?
A Moses threw down the tablets and ground up the golden calf.
- Q67 Why did God ask for an offering to be taken in the wilderness?
A God asked for an offering to make the tabernacle.
- Q68 If the people sinned, what were they to do?
A If the people sinned, they were to bring a sacrifice to be offered to God.
- Q69 What did God promise would happen to the Israelites if they disobeyed Him?
A Their enemies would live in their land, they would be scattered, and a sword would follow them.
- Q70 After Moses sent spies into Canaan, what report did they give?
A Joshua and Caleb gave a good report, but ten spies gave an evil report.

- Q71 What happened to the generation that refused to enter Canaan?
A They died in the wilderness, but their children went in after forty years.
- Q72 When the people complained and were bitten by snakes, what did Moses do?
A He lifted up a brass snake on a pole for people to look at and be healed.
- Q73 After Moses died, who led the Children of Israel?
A Joshua led the people after Moses died.
- Q74 Why did Joshua send two spies to Jericho?
A Joshua sent spies to view the land.
- Q75 What did Rahab do with the scarlet cord?
A Rahab used the scarlet cord to help the spies escape and as a sign for her safety.
- Q76 How did the people cross the Jordan River?
A The people crossed on dry ground in the midst of the Jordan River.
- Q77 How were the Children of Israel able to take Jericho?
A When they shouted, the walls of Jericho fell down.
- Q78 Why did Israel flee from their enemies at Ai?
A Israel fled because there was sin in the camp.
- Q79 How did Joshua deal with sin?
A He found the sinner and punished the sin.
- Q80 How much of the land did Joshua take?
A Joshua took all the land that the Lord told him to take.
- Q81 What did the children of Israel do after Joshua died?
A They forsook the Lord and served false gods.
- Q82 What helped to cause Israel to serve false gods?
A They married women who were unbelievers.
- Q83 How did people decide what to do in the days of the Judges?
A They did what was right in their own eyes.
- Q84 Why did God call Samuel?
A God called Samuel to be a prophet of the Lord in Israel.
- Q85 Why did Saul lose his kingdom?
A Saul lost his kingdom because he rejected God's word.
- Q86 What was it about David that made him special to God?
A David was "the apple of God's eye" because he served God with his whole heart.
- Q87 Why was Solomon's reign partly good and partly bad?
A Solomon served the Lord with a divided heart.
- Q88 What happened to the kingdom after Solomon's reign?
A After Solomon's reign, the kingdom was divided between Israel and Judah.
- Q89 Why did God send Elijah to the King?
A God sent Elijah with the word from the Lord.
- Q90 What was the contest on Mt. Carmel?
A The contest on Mt. Carmel was to see which was the true God.
- Q91 What convinced the people that the Lord was God?
A Fire from heaven revealed the true God.
- Q92 What happened when Israel refused to listen to God's prophets?
A Israel was taken into captivity by the Assyrians.
- Q93 Why did Judah go into captivity?
A Judah was captive to the Babylonians because they did evil in the sight of the Lord.

- Q94 Who gave authority for the Jewish people to return to Jerusalem?
A Cyrus the King of Persia sent the Jewish people back to Jerusalem.
- Q95 What was the first rebuilding project in Jerusalem?
A The first project was rebuilding the house of the Lord.
- Q96 What was the second rebuilding project in Jerusalem?
A The second project was to rebuild the walls.
- Q97 What was to be special about the birth of the Messiah?
A The Messiah would be born of a virgin.
- Q98 Where was the Messiah to be born?
A The Messiah was to be born in Bethlehem of Judea.
- Q99 What kind of ministry was the Messiah to have?
A The Messiah would be a prophet and a preacher.
- Q100 What would happen at the end of the Messiah's life?
A He would be betrayed, sold, and shamed.
- Q101 How would the Messiah die?
A The Messiah would be crucified.
- Q102 Where would the Messiah be buried?
A The Messiah would be buried in a rich man's tomb.
- Q103 What would happen to the Messiah after he died?
A He would not be dead long enough for his body to decay.
- Q104 Why are the Bible prophecies of the Messiah so special?
A The Bible promises are special since no other god exists that can give true prophecies of the future.
- Q105 What was special about the birth of Jesus?
A Jesus was born of a virgin.
- Q106 How did Joseph know what name to give Mary's baby?
A The angel of the Lord told Joseph to name the baby Jesus.
- Q107 Where was Jesus born?
A Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea.
- Q108 How did the shepherds know that Jesus was born?
A The angels told the shepherds that Jesus was born.
- Q109 How did Simeon know that Jesus was the Messiah?
A The Holy Spirit revealed to Simeon that Jesus was the Messiah.
- Q110 How did the Wise Men know Jesus was in Bethlehem?
A King Herod told them to go to Bethlehem to find the Christ child.
- Q111 Why was Jesus taken to Egypt?
A Jesus was taken to Egypt to escape Herod, who wanted to kill him.
- Q112 In what town was Jesus raised?
A Jesus was raised in Nazareth.
- Q113 What kind of little child was Jesus?
A As a child Jesus was wise and spiritually strong.
- Q114 When Jesus was 12, what was he doing in the temple in Jerusalem?
A Jesus was doing his Father's business in the temple.
- Q115 When Jesus spoke about doing his Father's business, how did Mary respond?
A Mary pondered these things in her heart.

- Q116 How did Jesus relate to Mary and Joseph when he was entering his teen years?
A Jesus was obedient to Mary and Joseph.
- Q117 Who did God send to bear witness of the Light?
A God sent John to bear witness of the Light.
- Q118 Who did John say he was?
A John said he was a voice crying in the wilderness.
- Q119 How did John introduce Jesus?
A John called Jesus the Lamb of God which taketh away the sin of the world.
- Q120 How did John turn his own disciples to Jesus?
A John continued to point them to Jesus.
- Q121 How was the Trinity involved in the introduction of Jesus' ministry?
A The Holy Spirit descended on Jesus the Son, and the Father spoke from heaven.
- Q122 What happened to Jesus just before he began his ministry?
A Jesus was in the wilderness forty days and tempted by the devil.
- Q123 How did Jesus begin his ministry?
A Jesus proclaimed that the time had come for the Gospel.
- Q124 How did Jesus assemble his disciples?
A Jesus called people to follow him.
- Q125 What did Jesus teach his disciples?
A He taught them how to live as part of the kingdom of heaven.
- Q126 How does a follower of Jesus change the world?
A They are like salt and light.
- Q127 How is living for the kingdom of God different from living by the law?
A Kingdom living is more righteous than living by the law.
- Q128 What is more important than giving offerings to God?
A Living with a Christian attitude toward others is more important than offerings.
- Q129 How did Jesus explain the Seventh Commandment?
A Jesus said that a look to lust is breaking the Seventh Commandment.
- Q130 Why is divorce wrong?
A Jesus said that divorce was a cause of adultery.
- Q131 What did Jesus teach about standing up for yourself or for your rights?
A Jesus gave examples of being meek in various ways.
- Q132 In what way did Jesus say we are to be perfect?
A Jesus taught us to be perfect in love.
- Q133 When we pray, give, or fast, how are we to act?
A We are to do these spiritual activities in secret.
- Q134 Why should we lay up treasures in heaven?
A Because thieves can't steal there, and rust can't harm there.
- Q135 What advantage is there in seeking God's Kingdom?
A If we seek God's Kingdom first, He will supply our earthly needs.
- Q136 Why are we not to judge others?
A If we judge others, we will be judged just as strictly ourselves.
- Q137 How does God respond to our requests?
A God gives us good things when we ask.
- Q138 Does the broad way or the narrow way lead to life?
A The narrow way leads to life.

- Q139 Who will enter the kingdom of heaven?
A Those who do the will of the Father will enter the kingdom of heaven.
- Q140 How does a wise man build his life?
A A wise man does the things that Jesus says he should do.
- Q141 What did Jesus preach to the people?
A Jesus preached that people should repent.
- Q142 What Gospel was Jesus preaching?
A Jesus was preaching the Gospel of the kingdom.
- Q143 Who did Jesus preach to that fulfilled prophecy?
A Jesus preached to the poor.
- Q144 What did Jesus preach that brought hope?
A Jesus preached that there was deliverance, freedom, and acceptance for sinners who repent.
- Q145 What kind of people did Jesus heal?
A Jesus healed the sick and those who were possessed with devils.
- Q146 What special woman did Jesus heal?
A Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law.
- Q147 Why were the two blind men healed?
A They had faith to be healed.
- Q148 Why was the Canaanite woman's daughter healed?
A Her mother had faith in the power of Jesus.
- Q149 When Jesus talked to the woman at the well who did he tell her he was?
A Jesus said he was the Messiah.
- Q150 Who did Jesus tell the Jews that he was?
A Jesus said God was his Father, making himself equal with God.
- Q151 Who did Jesus tell the disciples he was?
A Jesus said that he was the bread from heaven that if anyone ate, he would live forever.
- Q152 When Jesus spoke to Thomas, who did he claim to be?
A Jesus said he was the only way to the Father.
- Q153 What was the first miracle Jesus performed?
A Jesus' first miracle was turning water into wine.
- Q154 How did Jesus calm the storm?
A Jesus spoke and the storm was stilled.
- Q155 How did Jesus feed the 5,000?
A He blessed five loaves and two fishes.
- Q156 How did Jesus tell Peter to pay his taxes?
A Jesus told Peter to cast a line into the water, catch a fish and find money in the fish's mouth.
- Q157 What did Jesus teach us to pray?
A Jesus taught us to pray the Lord's Prayer.
- Q158 Why did Jesus pray out loud before Lazarus was raised from the dead?
A Jesus prayed out loud so that the people who heard him would believe.
- Q159 What did Jesus pray for his own disciples?
A Jesus prayed that the Father would sanctify his disciples.
- Q160 What did Jesus pray for those who crucified him?
A Jesus prayed that God would forgive them.

- Q161 What was the last Supper?
A The Last Supper was the Passover meal Jesus ate with his disciples before he was crucified.
- Q162 What did Jesus pray just before he was betrayed?
A Jesus asked his Father if the cup could be removed from him.
- Q163 What two questions did the council leaders ask Jesus?
A The council asked Jesus if he was the Christ and if he was the Son of God.
- Q164 At the trial of Jesus, who did Pilate send Jesus to?
A Pilate sent Jesus to Herod.
- Q165 When Pilate asked the people who should go free, Jesus or Barabbas, who did they choose?
A The people chose Barabbas to go free and called for Jesus to be crucified.
- Q166 Where was Jesus crucified?
A Jesus was crucified at Calvary.
- Q167 What did Jesus tell the thief on the cross?
A Jesus told him that they would be together that day in Paradise.
- Q168 When Jesus died, where was he buried?
A Jesus was buried in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathaea.
- Q169 Early Sunday morning, what did the women find at the tomb?
A The stone was rolled away and the body of Jesus was gone.
- Q170 What did Peter and John find in the tomb?
A Peter and John found the grave clothes and the face cloth.
- Q171 How did the disciples know that Jesus was risen?
A Jesus appeared to the disciples after he was risen from the dead.
- Q172 Why is the resurrection so important?
A If there is no resurrection, we have no hope.
- Q173 What promise did Jesus give the disciples?
A Jesus promised that the Holy Ghost would give them power to be witnesses of him.
- Q174 How did Jesus return to heaven?
A Jesus was taken up into a cloud.
- Q175 What happened to the disciples on the day of Pentecost?
A They were all filled with the Holy Spirit.
- Q176 What did Peter preach at Pentecost that caused so many people to believe?
A Peter preached that since Jesus fulfilled the prophecies of the Messiah, was crucified by the wicked hands of the Jews, and rose again, they should repent.
- Q177 How was the lame man at the gate healed?
A The lame man was healed in the name of Jesus.
- Q178 What did the leaders tell Peter and John after the lame man was healed?
A The leaders told Peter and John to stop preaching in the name of Jesus.
- Q179 Why did Ananias and Sapphira die?
A Ananias and Sapphira died because they lied to the Holy Ghost.
- Q180 Why was Stephen stoned to death?
A Stephen was stoned to death because he preached that the people had crucified Jesus.
- Q181 What did Philip preach to the Ethiopian?
A Philip preached about Jesus from the writings of the prophet Isaiah.
- Q182 Who convinced Saul of Tarsus that Jesus was the Lord?
A Jesus himself appeared to Saul and spoke to him.

- Q183 What did Peter learn at the conversion of Cornelius?
A Peter learned that the Gospel was for Gentiles as well as Jews.
- Q184 Where were the disciples first called Christians?
A The disciples were first called Christians at Antioch.
- Q185 What was Paul's assignment to Timothy at Ephesus?
A Timothy was to be sure that the church taught sound doctrine.
- Q186 What is very important for people in the church to do?
A They are to pray and live holy lives.
- Q187 What is required of those who are church leaders?
A Church leaders are to live blameless lives.
- Q188 Why is teaching right doctrine so important?
A Teaching right doctrine is important because living according to right doctrine has promise of salvation.
- Q189 Why did Paul believe the Holy Spirit was at work in the Thessalonians?
A Paul knew about their faith and joy, and that they followed the true God.
- Q190 What was lacking in the faith of the Thessalonian Christians?
A They needed their hearts to be established unblameable in holiness.
- Q191 To what did God call His people?
A God called his people to holiness.
- Q192 To what extent will God sanctify His people?
A God will sanctify them wholly, their whole spirit, soul and body.
- Q193 What is the benefit of having your faith tested?
A Faith that is tested brings glory to God.
- Q194 When does God get the most glory from Christians suffering?
A When Christians suffer well for doing good.
- Q195 What kind of witness is it to the world when Christians suffer well?
A Christian suffering brings shame on their accusers.
- Q196 How is a Christian to respond who is called to suffer for Christ?
A A Christian who suffers for Christ is to give glory to God.
- Q197 What will mark scoffers in the last days?
A Scoffers will make fun of Christ's return.
- Q198 Who did Jesus warn would deceive many in the last days?
A Jesus warned that many false prophets would deceive many.
- Q199 What will be a major compromise in the last days?
A People will turn away from the truth and listen to fables.
- Q200 What are Christians to do in the last days?
A Christians are to earnestly contend for the true faith.
- Q201 What is the book of Revelation about?
A The book of Revelation is about future things.
- Q202 What is the war that Revelation describes?
A Revelation describes a war between Satan and God's people.
- Q203 What is the mark of the beast?
A The mark of the beast is a mark that everyone must have to be able to buy or sell.
- Q204 What will happen to those who receive the mark of the beast?
A Those who take the mark of the beast will experience the wrath of God.

- Q205 What will happen at the great judgment?
A The dead will be judged by their works at the great judgment.
- Q206 What happens to people whose names are not in the Book of Life?
A Those whose names are not in the Book of Life will be cast into the lake of fire.
- Q207 What will heaven be like?
A Heaven will be where all things are new and God dwells with his people.
- Q208 What is God's final invitation?
A God invites people who will to come to Him.
